White Wines

By the glass & bottle

Glenn Ellen - Pinot Grigio

California, USA

A light clean crisp wine bursting with flavors and aromas of citrus, nectarine, melon and apple. With a fruity mouthful that delights. Perfectly paired with salads, garlic noodles and chicken.

Colombelle – Colombard/Ugna Blanc/Listan

Côtes de Gascogne, France

Fresh and intense floral and fruity notes. The ripeness of the grape gives a smooth and tasty balance of ripe fruits like pineapple, peach and guava.

Alkoomi – Riesling

Australia

Citrus peel and white flower with hints of talc and musk. Intense yet delicate flavors of lemon and grapefruit and musk, bright acidity.

Old world wines

Cave Anne de Joyeuse - Viognier

IGP Pays d'Oc L – Roussillon, France

Bright golden appearance with a fresh fruity nose. On the palate, the wines show flavours of grapefruit and pineapple.

VDP Collines Rhodaniennes Cheze Marsanne

Northern Rhone, France

There's hints of grapefruit, apricot, lemon, smoke, Mineral. Palate: the wine is Dry, with Medium Acidity, and is Medium + bodied. On Palate, there's also hints of blossom, green bell pepper. Finish /Length is rather Medium.

Domaine de la Saraziniere Le Pavillon - Chardonnay

Burgundy, France

Very fresh, clean and well made. Quite ethereal, impressive, light crisp fruit at the beginning with a background of fairly rich complexity on the finish.

Chateau de Roquefort Petit Sale - Clairette, Rolle

Provence, France

Pale in color with a fine bouquet of floral and mineral notes and a whisper of white peach and lemon. Lively and precise on the palate, definitely influenced by limestone and flint soils, and delightfully fresh.

Champalou Vin Sec - Chenin Blanc

Loire Valley, France

Dry wine with medium acidity, freshness of citrus, light bodied and crisp. Well paired with a light salad or fresh fish and seafood .

Bourgogne – Aligote

Burgundy, France

Dry, crisp and elegant everyday drinking wine. Refreshing finish with vibrant acidity. Great with crab, shellfish and pasta in cream sauce.

Mittnacht Freres AOC Alsace - Sylvaner

Alsace, France

The palate is more complex than a "classic" Sylvaner: powerful, slightly supple in the middle of the mouth, with flavors reminiscent of the fruits of our orchards and a hint of fresh butter.

Brunori Azienda Vitivinicola, Le Gemme - Verdicchio

Marche, Italy

Straw yellow with greenish highlights. Intense, persistent, fine, delicately aromatic, reminiscent of broom. Intense, persistent, dry, fresh, smooth, balanced with a delicate bitterish flavour.

Cos Pithos Bianco – Grecanico

Sicily, Italy

A wonderful combination of herbs (mint) and spice (cardamom). The bouquet is enticing with dried peach and candied fruit, a hint of orange and almonds. This wine gives you a dry mouthfeel.

San Marzano Santoro – Trebbiano

Italy

Light, fruity and dry with aromas of lemon and green apple. Lovely to pair with light meals, like salads and olive oil based pasta.

Azienda Agricola Occhipinti , Tami Grillo - Grillo

Sicily, Italy

The nose displays aromas of tangerine blossoms, jasmine tea, chalky minerals and white figs. There is ample fruit on the palate, dominated by a tropical citrus fruit core and great minerality.

Txakoli Itsasmendi No7 – Hondarrabi Zuri, Riesling

Spain

Itsasmendi No7 is bright lemon-yellow with an intense bouquet of grapefruit, fresh herbs, and orange blossoms. On the palate, the wine is full bodied and rich with zesty acidity, giving it nice structure. The Hondarrabi Zuri gives it a refreshing acidity and the Riesling imparts floral and steely notes.

Penedes Blanc Seleccio - Macabeo, Xarello, Picapoll

Catalonia, Spain

Blanc Seleccio has a pale color with medium intensity on the nose that develops into fruity notes of apple and anise. The palate is very smooth with a balanced and pleasant aftertaste.

CELLER DEL ROURE, Cullerot - Pedro Ximenez, Macabeo, Chardonnay

DOP Valencia

Setze Gallet has an herbal, balsamic nose with creaminess that is unusual for an unoaked red, with the aromas of licorice developing tremendously with time in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with fine-grained, polished tannins, balanced acidity and is quite round with focused flavors.

Rias Baixas Leirana – Albarino

Galicia, Spain

Leirana presents a very clean, bright, straw yellow color with a golden tinge. On the nose, fresh aromas of white fruit, citrus and passion fruit, combined with hints of aromatic herbs, balsam, aniseed, and an underlying salty and mineral remembrance. Palate is savoury and fresh with notes of peach, apple, lime, fresh hay and some mineral undertones. It has very precise acidity and a long yet subtle finish.

Ribera del Duero Lovamor – Albillo

Castillo y Leon, Spain

Lovamor is a golden yellow, full-bodied wine with bright acidity and elegant notes of ripe white fruit, quince and floral nuances. On the palate, it is structured with a pleasant mouth feel, fruity notes and some final warmth.

Finca La Emperatriz - Viura

Rioja, Spain

Very pale yellow in colour, with a hint of green. Intense aromas of white fruits, flowers and citrus, together with elements of creaminess. On the palate it is both full, but light, with a refreshing acidity which balances out the richness. The after taste leaves a sensation of juiciness. An excellent example of the potential of Viura in Rioja, if it is grown in the right soils.

Vinho Verde Mica – Loureiro, Azal, Arinto

Sousa, Portugal

Mica is a fresh and elegant white Vinho Verde. It features intense citric and green apple notes with a wet stone mineral character. The palate is vibrant and intense with fresh fruit flavors and exceptional lightness. This wine has been certified organic by ECOCERT.

New world wines

Woodstock Botrytis - Semillon

Mclaren Vale, Australia

Botrytis Cinerea, a pink and furry mould, is responsible for this delicious drink. The mould pierces the skins then feeds on the juice of the berries causing them to shrivel and concentrate. Mild and humid conditions are favourable for its onset and usually occurs at the end of the growing sea-season. A somewhat messy winemaking process, but the resulting wine is a beauty from the beast.

Katnook Founder's Block - Chardonnay

Coonawarra, Australia

The Colour straw yellow with tinges of green, has attractive Chardonnay aromas of peach and nectarine, along with zesty grapefruit. Subtle crème caramel and creamy notes add a lovely touch of complexity. On the palate appealing flavours of white peach, pear and citrus, with hints of brioche, highlight the elegant palate. The mouth feel is subtly rich and creamy with elegant oak, enticing fruit and fine acid that is fresh and lingering.

Sons of Eden Freya - Riesling

Eden Valley, Australia

Pale straw hues. Aromatic and intense, pure lemon citrus and lemon sherbet characters, supported by savoury chalkiness and calico notes. Lemon lime citrus on the palate, accompanied by a tight mineral line. The long fine length of flavour is supported by crisp natural acidity, judiciously dry in style, resolving on an aromatic lilac, lemon floral finish.

Marlborough Vines – Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough, New Zealand

Classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc – fresh, powerful and zingy.

The Ned – Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough, New Zealand

Award-winning winery of the year 2011. Bright, fresh and vibrant with a wonderful minerality, adding structure and depth to an already classy wine. Fruit balance and textural weight on the palate and the crisp acidity make the ripe herbaceous characters come alive in this wine.

The King's Bastard – Chardonnay

Marlborough, New Zealand

Ripe melon, peach and fig with fresh brioche, layers of fig and cashew supported by subtle oak spice.

The King's Favour - Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough, New Zealand

Aromas of lime zest and citrus blossom fragrance sit atop richer, more exotic elements of musky, pink grapefruit and black current hedge. On the palate edgy leafy greens are given intensity and cut from vivid lime – tinged acids, whilst the riper citrus elements & the signature wet stone minerality reveal themselves on the long, finely textured finish.

Spy Valley - Pinot Gris

Marlborough, New Zealand

Flavours of white peach, almond, lemon skin and quince. Mouthfilling and rich, this wine has an elegance and tension that suggests it will be a great cellaring prospect.

Rustenberg Stellenbosch - Chardonnay

South Africa

Apricot, coconut and orange peel aromas followed by flavours of marzipan, sponge cake and citrus rounded off with carefully judged oak and balanced, fresh acidity.

Red Wines

By the glass & bottle

Glen Ellen – Cabernet Sauvignon

California

Medium bodied wine with juicy flavors of berry, black cherry and soft tannins for a rich finish. A good pairing with red meats, game and red-sauced pastas.

Colombelle – Merlot/Tannat/Cabernet

Côtes de Gascogne, France

This delicious and refreshing rosé is soft, fresh and fruity with a smell of citrus and white fruit. Ideal for a BBQ, red fish and light meats.

Alkoomi – Shiraz

Frankland River, Australia

Depp ruby with magenta hues with lifted aromas of dark cherry, plum and spice with nuances of cedary oak on the nose. On the palate you can enjoy its medium body with flavors of juicy ripe plums, blackberries and dark chocolate.

Old world wines

Cave Anne de Joyeuse IGP Pays d'Oc - Cabernet Sauvignon

Roussillon, France

Strong red color. Intense aromas of black fruits and spices. Well-structured and balanced in the mouth. It is ready for drinking now but can also be kept for several years.

Chateau de Roquefort Gueule de Loup - Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault, Carignan, Rolle

Provence, France

Crimson red with violet highlights. Fruity with fragrances of herbs, spices and cinnamon. Rustic wine that is a perfect match for strong tasting dishes.

Cox Pinot Noir - Pinot Noir

VDP d'Oc L – Roussillon, France

Fresh, fruity and typical nose of Pinot Noir. Has a good complexity of aromas-red fruits, cherries and coffee. The wine is very fruity, smooth and light in the mouth, and has a balanced and silky finish.

Cuvee de Galets - Grenache, Carignan

Southern Rhone, France

Simple and fruity red wine with mild tannins. Wine is unfiltered thus may appear hazy. Nose of cassis and strawberry, licorice in the mouth.

AOC Cahors Benjamin Lamartine - Malbec, Merlot

Southwest France

Red cherry in color. Rich nose of licorice and crushed red fruits. Round, fleshy and elegant tannins.

Ermitage Tour de Pierres - Grenache, Mouvedre, Syrah

Pic Saint- Loup, France

Intense deep color. Expressive nose suggestive of forest fruits backed by mild spices. Powerful, well-balanced palate offering up distinctive Languedoc aromatics (fruit, spice...). A classic, well-made Pic Saint-Loup.

Les Demoiselle de Falfas - Blend of Merlot,

Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon'

Bordeaux, France

Scents of vanilla and cinnamon with a long length and great taste of black berries. Perfect for braised red meat and rich fish.

Chateauneuf du Pape - Blend of Grenache and Syrah

France

Complex aromas dominated by red fruits, truffles and mushrooms. Powerful round and spicy with a good long finish – A classic French wine. Good for all occasions, especially with red meats and strong cheeses.

Force de France-Costiere de Nimes - Syrah, Grenache, Mourvedre

Southern Rhone, France

Garnet red coloured wine. Its scent of ripe fruit is dominated by blackcurrant underlined with hints of spices and pepper. In the mouth, it is a little bit sweet, round and harmonious with long smooth tannins.

Brunori Azienda Vitivinicola, DOC Rosso Cornero Barco - Montepulciano

Marche, Italy

Intense, persistent and vinous in the first period; these features lessen with ageing giving way to smells of ripe fruit and dried red flowers. Dry, tannic, sapid, stringent, acquires smoothness with ageing.

Cantine San Marzano, Poggio del Sole Negroamaro - Negroamaro

IGP Salento, Puglia – Italy

Purple red with violet-black reflections; intense aroma, with wild fruit scent and pepper notes. Good structure, soft and balanced, sapid in the end.

Da Vinci "Brunello di Montalcino" - Sangiovese'

Toscana, Italy

This wine is refined for 2 years in oak barrels. A wine with strong personality and longevity which immediately presents itself with an intense fruity bouquet of mulberries, blackberries and cherries.

Da Vinci "Rosso di Montalcino" - Sangiovese'

Toscana, Italy

Aged for 8 months in oak barrels, this wine is round and well-balanced, characterized by intense fruits nose of cherry, blackberry and blackcurrant. The finish is long and persistent.

Santoro Tere di Chieti - Sangiovese

Puglia, Italy

Vibrant red fruit with herbal undertones, vanilla and oak with spice, lively acidity and firm tannins.

Castello di Verduno Barbaresco DOCG - Nebbiolo

Piedmont, Italy

Combines red fruits, such as strawberry and raspberry, in perfection. With a hint of vanilla and caramel, good acidity, high tannins and a long length

DOP Valencia Les Alcusses - Monastrell, Garnacha Tintorera, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah

Valencia, Spain

Les Alcusses elicits intense aromas of black and red fruit mixed with spicy notes; light notes of vegetation and balsamic; and soft toasted notes due to its short time in oak. The palate has good acidity and nice, ripe tannins, with a good, long finish of fruity sensations and a roasted aftertaste.

Envinate T Amarela Extremadura Sin D.O. - Tinta Amarela

Extremadura, Spain

T Amarela is a lovely red wine that best expresses the characteristics of the Tinta Amarela grape (known in nearby Portugal's as Trincadeira). Produced in the Parcela Valdemedel, this wine displays a beautiful fragrance of strawberries, raspberries, blackberries, licorice and black pepper, with a silky texture and lengthy finish.

Envinate Albahra Almansa Sin D.O. - Garnacha Tintorera

Castile-La Mancha – Murcia, Spain

Albahra, Envinate's wine from this region, is a fresh wine evoking dark, earthy fruit and spice, making it a perfect complement to dishes like paella and roasted meats.

Casa Castillo , Jumilla - Tempranillo, Garnacha, Monastrell'

Murcia, Spain

Monastrell is aromatic and elegant, with a palate that feels very complete, nicely balanced, with great acidity and a very fine thread which makes it nicely textured.

Celler del Roure Setze Gallets - Garnacha Tintorera, Monastrell, Merlot, Mando, Cabernet

Valencia, Spain

Setze Gallet has an herbal, balsamic nose with creaminess that is unusual for an unoaked red, with the aromas of licorice developing tremendously with time in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with fine-grained, polished tannins, balanced acidity and is quite round with focused flavors.

Rijoa Corriente - Tempranillo, Garnacha, Graciano

Navarre, Spain

Corriente has an intense cherry red color with garnet rim. The nose has a medium intensity, with highlights of ripe red fruit, slightly spicy and balsamic notes and memories of toasted nuts and vanilla. The palate has notes of aging with good acidity and freshness, with fruit and spicy memories standing out. The end is bitter, dry and medium-haul.

Castilla y Leon El Rey del Glam – Garnacha

Castilla y Leon, Spain

El Rey del Glam is an experimental cuvee made with carbonic maceration that comes from two different 100% Garnacha vineyards of varying ages. Half of the cuvee comes from old vines planted on granite soils in the town of Navarredondilla, Avila province, located in the Sierra de Gredos mountain range; the other half of the cuvee comes from moderately old vines planted on calcareous clay soils in the town of Peñafiel, Ribera del Duero. This is a medium bodied wine with layers of juicy fruit and spice, best drunk young when the wine is at its most vibrant.

New world wines

Heartland Spice Trader - Shiraz, Cabernet

Sauvignon

Langhorne Creek, Australia

This is an intense glass of juicy and delicious red. A burst of dark primary fruit hits the palate with a compote of blueberries, blackberries and currants. These powerful fruit notes can engulf the uninitiated, but waves of spice, fresh spearmint and dried herbs can be discovered by seasoned flavour explorers.

Stella Bella - Cabernet Sauvignon

Margaret River, Australia

Brick red with a purple hue. The bouquet is rich with inky cassis, redcurrant, maraschino cherry, tobacco leaves and deep fried sage. Subtle mocha and a sweetness from the vanillin oak complement the fruit aromas. Full bodied with assertive, brick dust tannins. The dense palate is dark and brooding with blackberry, blueberries and couverture. Oak integration is seamless. There is a sense of both elegance and power; the flavours deepen and spread across the palate, freshened with balanced acidity, building to a tight and fine pure cabernet finish.

Woodstock The Octogenarian – Grenache Tempranillo

Mclaren Vale, Australia

Bright colour and lifted aromas of cherries, plums and raspberries. Tem-pranillo adds dried spice notes to the nose and savoury tannins to the palate. Lively and expressive on both nose and palate, this Grenache Tempranillo blend captures true McLaren Vale characters; silky structure with subtle complexities making it a great food companion.

Woodstock - Shiraz

Mclaren Vale, Australia

When tasting this Shiraz, generosity of color and flavor are clear and evident. The vibrant, floral and spicy bouquet brings together both red and black fruits like cherries and plums. The classic McLaren Vale earthiness comes through on the palate which balances the fruit concentration and the soft yet structured tannins.

Mitolo 7th Son - Grenache, Shiraz

Mclaren Vale, Australia

Grenache is the dominant grape in the blend and it shows on the nose with highly fragrant and earthy characters of dried herbs and tobacco. The Shiraz complements these characters with beautiful sweeter aromatics of ripe red cherries and mint. On the palate it is mid-weighted with bright acidity and heart-warming earthy, savoury characters of dried herb and tar sitting perfectly alongside delicate raspberry and cherry. The tannins are prominent yet fine and mouth coating providing a wonderful framework for the juicy mid-palate.

Andeluna Altitud – Malbec

Argentina

Aromas of diverse fruits and flavors, with notes of 'deluce de leche' vanilla and chocolate given by its ageing in oak barrels. Smooth, balanced and full bodied with soft tannins.

Errazuriz “Max Reserva” - Carmenere

Aconcagua Valley, Chile

Dark violet color with black pepper, sweet spices and chocolate. Well balanced wine with rounded tannins that lead to an intense and pleasant finish.

Te Mata Estate 1896 - Syrah

Hawke's Bay, New Zealand

Bright red with a purple hue, a glass of Estate Vineyards Syrah '15 is like opening a spicebox. It overflows with cherry, blackberry, boysenberry, thyme, pepper and the irresistible scents of Black Doris plum and vanilla. There's floral lift and charm here, but also a supplepalate with luxurious savoury fruit and enticing notes of red and black liquorice. The perfume and depth of this syrah is matched by its fine, textural expression, balance and soft, even tannins.

Rosé

By the glass & bottle

Colombelle – Merlot/Tannat/Cabernet

Côtes de Gascogne, France

This delicious and refreshing rosé is soft, fresh and fruity with a smell of citrus and white fruit. Ideal for a BBQ, red fish and light meats.

Cave Anne de Joyeuse Social Club Rose - Malbec, Syrah

Languedoc-Roussillon, France

A fruity rose with aromas of wild berries, vanilla and black pepper. Easy to drink and approachable. A perfect rose for hot summer days.

By the bottle

Chateau de Roquefort Corail - Grenache, Syrah

Provence, France

Clear pink with opal reflects. Delicate smells of white and red fruits mixed with floral scents. The palate is elegant, dry, round and structured.

Champagnes & Sparkling Wines

By the glass & bottle

Corinto Sparkling - Chardonnay

Maule Valley, Chile

Pale yellow, bright & persistent bubbles. Aromas of apple, custard apple and hints of almond. Lively in mouth, fresh with good acidity, medium volume, balanced and enjoyable. It is recommended with cold dishes, seafood and salads.

By the bottle

Christophe Brut “Tradition” – Pinot Noir

Champagne, France

This is an expressive wine which mingles fragrances of red fruits from their heritage pinot noir. Fleshy and simple, the palate is crisp, with a subtle honeyed finish, which blends citrus notes, pastry and roasted almonds.

Ruinart Blanc de Blancs Champagne - Chardonnay

Champagne, France

The nose is powerfully reminiscent of fresh fruits with dominant notes of citrus and exotic fruits, followed by a touch of jasmine, white peaches and pink peppercorns. A tribute to the radiant brilliance of the chardonnay, the symbolic grape of this cuvée. With its exceptional aromatic freshness, Ruinart Blanc de Blancs is a subtle union of elegance and lightness.

Sparkling Wine: La Collina dei Ciliegi “W2B”

- Prosecco DOC suggested by Luca Gardini

Veneto, Italy

This classic Prosecco opens with a fine yet persistent perlage. Aromas of lemon and grapefruit are met by an intense pear aroma. Pleasant acidity and a well balanced flavor of acacia fruit makes this Prosecco the perfect aperitif.

Cremant de Bourgogne – Blanc de Blancs

Burgundy, France

A wine bursting with youth and audacity, its freshness and vigour is a matter of general agreement. It's white gold in color. The bubbles are fine and form a delicate necklace around the edge of the glass. Carries the perfume of white flowers, citrus fruits and green apples.

Toi Toi Sparkling

Marlborough, New Zealand

The palate has excellent balance with a medium-dry finish, and flavours of gooseberries, passionfruit and lime will delight. A flavoursome wine, with the added excitement of bubbles!
